In addition to Outstanding T&L, you can expect to receive timely support tailored to the future you aspire to. This is all delivered through assemblies, PSHE, and our Curriculum Enrichment programme. As well as the plethora of opportunities available to develop your skills, we run the following programmes throughout Year 12:

AspiringMinds

This programme is aimed at students wishing to apply through the highly selective Oxbridge application process.

This starts in March with a visiting speaker from Oxford's Keble College and then there will be a series of sessions designed to stimulate and challenge students to prepare for the rigour of the application and interview process. The programme will also provide students with an opportunity to hear from our SGGS alumnae who are currently studying at the University of Oxford and Cambridge.

MedMinds

MedMinds is an extensive programme to support students wishing to apply for Medicine, Dentistry, or Veterinary Science. Students will be taken through practical and discussion-based activities and also learn about the profession from a number of visiting speakers specialising in different aspects of Medicine.

The course is designed to encourage students to broaden their portfolios and create evidence for a competitive Personal Statement.

PracticalMinds

Students who are interested in pursuing a degree apprenticeship will be led through a number of sessions which will help to support them with applying for apprenticeship vacancies and preparing them for the recruitment process used by employers. The programme, which is in partnership with ASK, will also provide students with the opportunity to hear from local employers about their apprenticeship opportunities and SGGS alumnae who have taken the Degree Apprenticeship pathway since leaving SGGS.
