

Admissions Consultation: 2020 entry

Under the Admissions Code, admissions authorities must determine their admission arrangements annually. Where changes are proposed to those arrangements, the admissions authority must first publicly consult on those arrangements; and where no changes are proposed, they must still be consulted on every seven years. Consultation must be for six weeks and must take place between 1 October and 31 January of the year before those arrangements are to apply. Admission authorities must determine admission arrangements by 28 February in the determination year.

The admissions arrangements which the governors of Stratford Girls' Grammar School propose for entry in September 2020 are given below.

The main change we are proposing is to introduce three further categories to the oversubscription criteria for entry to the sixth form;

Category 2: Children attracting the Pupil Premium⁵ via free school meals pupil premium who meet the entry criteria for Sixth Form.

Category 4: Looked After or Previously Looked After who score four points under the entry score
and

Category 5: Children in receipt of Pupil Premium who score four points under the entry score.

All other changes to the previous policy are essentially technical.

The policy is nonetheless being posted on the website for information, with such changes as are being made highlighted in red (dates) or green (other changes).
