#### **National Careers Week 2021 Review**

#### **Alumnae Success stories and Careers Videos**

Feedback from students included comments on the wide range of jobs available, including opportunities not heard of before. Students particularly enjoyed hearing about what past SGGS students have gone on to do, how they prepared for their careers, what qualifications they needed, and how they reached their goals.

#### Careers and the Curriculum

As well as hearing from alumnae, university students, apprentices, employers and employees, students have also been learning about links to careers through their subjects. In particular, the Biology department launched the 'Step into the NHS' competition, which saw students from Year 8 to Year 12 finding out more about the breadth of careers on offer in the NHS, and using personality quizzes to match themselves with potential roles, before designing their own job descriptions. Talk to your daughter about what she got involved in last week, what she learnt from it and what her career plans are.

Thanks go to our House Captains who themed last week's House quiz around the past careers of famous personalities and of our own SGGS staff. Debates over which of our teachers have previously served royalty, worked as a milkman, and worked in fashion design were reportedly intense!
